STATE CHAMBER/AIA BILL TRACKING

To date the House has filed 68 bills and the Senate has filed 50 bills.

ASA HUTCHINSON SWORN IN AS 46TH GOVERNOR OF ARKANSAS

After taking the Oath of Office before a joint session of the House and Senate in the House Chamber, Governor Asa Hutchinson outlined his plans to lead Arkansas in the 90th General Assembly. His first order of business is the creation of economic growth and increase jobs.

Hutchinson's first action will be to seek an income tax cut for the middle class. He plans to present a balanced budget to the General Assembly by the end of this week. His proposed budget will include savings and efficiencies with full funding for education.

Specific plans for education include an initiative to have computer science offered in every high school in Arkansas. He said Arkansas students should not lag behind the nation.

He wants the Arkansas Economic Development Commission to do all it can to make Arkansas competitive.

On healthcare reform, Hutchinson asked the General Assembly to be patient. He will make an address on January 22.

Criminal justice reform was another major issue Hutchinson spoke about in his Inaugural address. He said our prisons are over capacity with related problems in the parole program. Arkansas must take action on jail space, a more effective parole system and change the behavior of parolees.
